

# 10-Year Planning Process

In 2016, the Citizen Commission will complete the final year of the initial ten-year tax preference review cycle.

Looking ahead to the next ten-year review cycle, the Commission is addressing how to best determine when and which preferences to review, as well as the questions covered in the reviews.

At the April 22 meeting, the Commission will focus its discussion on issue papers drafted by JLARC staff. These issues were discussed at the August 2015 Commission meeting.

The Commission’s schedule for finalizing the 10-year review schedule, which was adopted at the September meeting, is below.
